# ST AUGUSTINE'S CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL AND SIXTH FORM

## DEVELOPING THE WHOLE PERSON

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### Introduction

St Augustine's Sixth form receive funding from the Education Funding Agency to enable eligible student's financial assistance via the 16-19 Bursary Fund. Applicants should apply by **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2021** with the required evidence to support their application. Successful applicants will receive three termly payments over the Academic year subject to satisfactory attendance and conduct.

### Criteria and Eligibility

85% of the funding will be distributed to the successful applicants that have applied by the **5<sup>th</sup> November 2021**. The remaining 15% will be held for late applications.

### 16-19 Bursary

These students will receive up to £1,200 for the year based on enrolling on a Full Time (EFA funded) course and meet the conditions of funding.

#### a) 16-19 Bursary students are:

- Young people in care
- Care leavers
- Young people in receipt of Income Support or Universal Credit in their own right
- Disabled young people in receipt of both Employment Support Allowance and Disability Living Allowance or Personal Independence Payments

#### b) Discretionary Fund

The remaining sum after the allocation of 16-19 Bursary Funds will be distributed to eligible students.

**Discretionary Fund** students are:

**Group A:** Claim Free School Meals for the current academic year or household income is less than £16,190

**Group B:** Student whose household income is between £16,190 - £22,500

**Group C:** Student whose household income is between £22,500 - £27,500

### Conditions of Funding

Students are expected to have a minimum attendance of 95%, good behaviour and demonstrate a good work ethic. Students must have zero unauthorised absences.

Students who are eligible for this funding should be aware that the additional financial support they receive in the form of the grant should be used to help off-set costs directly linked to their education, for example;

- Transport
- Books and Equipment
- Hardship Costs
- Additional Course Costs
- Costs of travel to HE interviews

Students in receipt of this grant funding will not be eligible or granted any further financial support from the school in help towards these costs. Students will also be required to inform the school of changes in their financial circumstances.

## Evidence for Application

### 16-19 Bursary

Evidence of the eligibility in form of:

- **Income Support** - Entitlement/Award letter dated within the last 3 months
- **Job Seekers Allowance** - Entitlement/Award letter dated within the last 3 months
- **Employment Support Allowance** - Entitlement/Award letter dated within the last 3 months
- **Incapacity Allowance** - Entitlement/Award letter dated within the last 3 months
- **Carer's Allowance** - Entitlement/Award letter dated within the last 3 months
- **Any other benefit** - Entitlement/Award letter dated within the last 3 months
- **Disability Living Allowance** - Entitlement/Award letter dated within the last 3 months

### Discretionary Fund

- **Group A:** Letter from the Local Authority
- **Group B:** Working Tax Credit annual statement letter from HMRC showing household income or P60 for the tax year 2020-2021
- **Group C:** Working Tax Credit annual statement letter from HMRC showing household income or P60 for the tax year 2020-2021

## Procedure for Application

Applications should be received by **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2021**. Late Applications will be considered however maximum funds may not be available. Applications should be submitted with adequate evidence as inadequate evidence will not be accepted and the student may not then qualify.

Applications should be marked for the attention of the **Finance Officer** and handed to the Finance Office. **Please ensure you have completed the BACS form in full as payment cannot be administered without the details.**

Each application will be considered in accordance with the fund guidelines. The claim forms will be sent to the Finance Team who will then administer the appropriate payment to each student.

Appeals must be made in writing to MAC Chief Finance Officer, Ms L Armfield within 4 weeks of the decisions. All information supplied will be treated in the strictest of confidence throughout the process and all original documentation will be returned once the applications have been verified.

### Timing of Payments

- Autumn Term Payment October Half term 50%
- Spring Term Payment February Half term 20%
- Summer Term Payment May Half Term 30%

### Important Notes

- All payments will be made BACS.
- Regrettably, we are unable to make payments to anyone other than the student.
- Students should ensure they have a bank account in their name through which to receive funds.
